

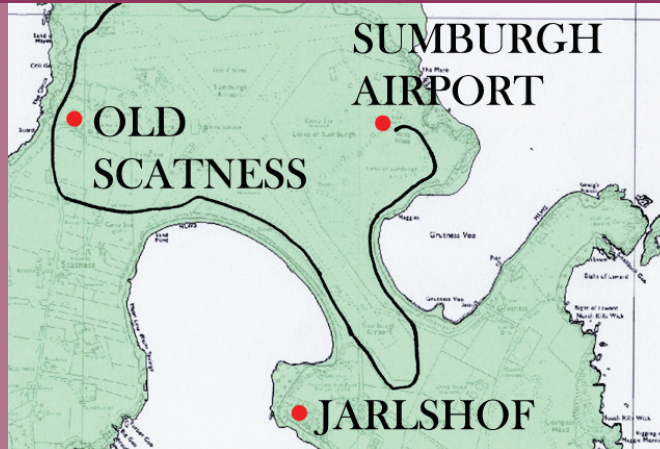


## Visitor Centre and Shop
